- Have Had a History of Ice Jams & Floods
- 2013 Floods More Severe than in the Past
- No Power Sub-Station Flooded 3-Days (Still Patched)
- 5-6 Weeks No Drinking Water
  - Aqueduct Compromised
- Sewage Backed-Up

- Original Contingency Plan
- Churches Were Used for Shelters
- County 911 Recommended Changes
- 911 Will Direct

#### **EVACUATION**

- Police/Fire Used for Evacuation
- Communication/Needs
