The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding can provide up to \$1 million in critical funding to help local governments and organizations address accessibility in public buildings and spaces. CDBG funds can create inclusive environments that benefit everyone in public buildings, including:

- County/City/Town/Village Municipal Buildings
- Libraries
- Community Centers

Accessibility Matters

- Equal access for individuals with disabilities
- Safe, inclusive public spaces
- Comply with ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) regulations
- Improve community engagement and civic participation

CDBG funds can support a wide range of accessibility modifications, including:

- Ramps, elevators, and lifts
- Automatic door openers
- Accessible restrooms and entrances
- Braille signage and auditory assistive devices
- Sidewalk and curb improvements

- Identify Community Needs – Assess the specific accessibility needs in your community.
- Develop a Project Plan – Outline the scope, goals, and expected outcomes.
- Secure Partnerships – Collaborate with local organizations and stakeholders.
