The **New York State Community Development Block Grant (NYS CDBG) program** provides funding to eligible local governments for housing, infrastructure, public facilities, and economic development projects. Administered by the Office of Community Renewal (OCR), the program helps communities address critical needs and foster sustainable growth, with a focus on low- and moderate-income residents.

Why Apply for NYS CDBG Funding?

- **Enhance Quality of Life:** Improve access to safe and affordable housing, infrastructure, and public facilities.
- **Boost Local Economies:** Support businesses, create jobs, and foster entrepreneurship.
- **Strengthen Community Resilience:** Invest in long-term sustainability and disaster preparedness.
- **Flexible Funding:** Grants can be tailored to meet specific community needs.

Who Can Apply?

Eligible applicants include non-entitlement units of local government, such as towns, villages, and counties. These municipalities can apply on behalf of eligible projects that benefit low- and moderate-income residents.

How to Apply?

The application process is managed by the Office of Community Renewal (OCR) and follows an annual funding cycle. Local governments must submit project proposals that align with CDBG funding priorities. 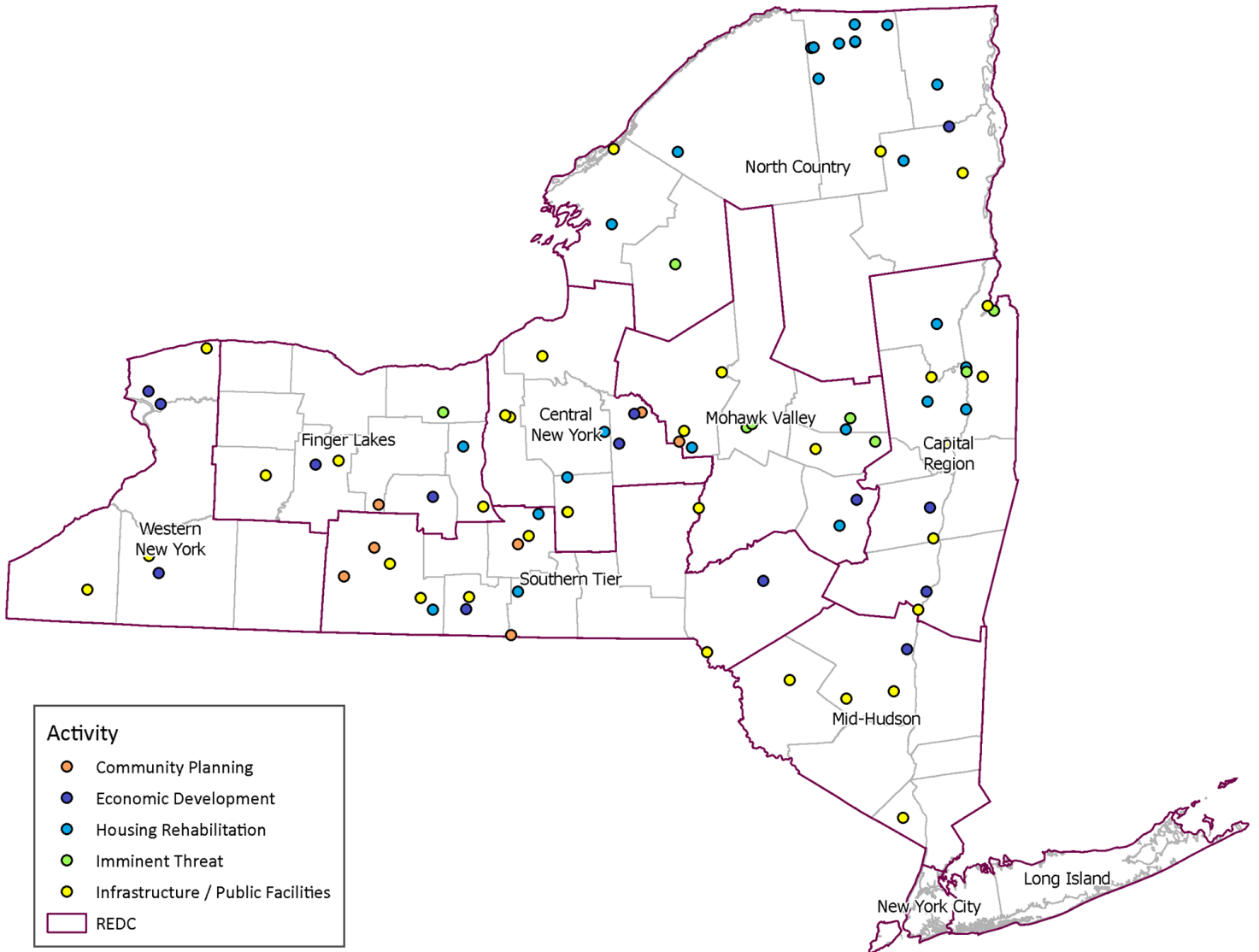
