Eligible Projects Include:

- Drinking water and wastewater improvements inside a manufactured housing park
- New wells and septic systems for homeowners
- Decommissioning existing wells and septic with lateral connections to public systems
- Replacement of lead lateral connections
- Can include engineering and design

- **Develop a Project Plan** – Outline the scope, goals, and expected outcomes.
- **Secure Partnerships** – Collaborate with local organizations and stakeholders.
- **Consult with HCR** – Submit an application.
