



# CDBG Imminent Threat Program

Protecting Communities in Times of Crisis

When emergency situations put lives, property, and essential infrastructure at risk, the **New York State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Imminent Threat Program** is here to help with up to \$1 million in critical funding. Designed to provide funding, this program assists communities in responding to urgent needs that threaten public health, safety, and welfare.

CDBG IT funds can be used for a variety of critical needs, including:

- **Disaster Recovery & Mitigation:** Repairing infrastructure, clearing debris after floods, fires, or other natural disasters. Post recovery efforts may include rebuilding damaged water systems, stabilizing slopes to prevent erosion, and removing hazardous debris that threatens public safety.
- **Infrastructure Repair:** Addressing public water systems, sewer lines, roads, or bridges that pose an immediate danger.
- **Demolition and Clearance:** Addressing properties that pose a threat to public health and safety.

**Funding for imminent threat response will require the activity to meet CDBG National Objective.**

### How to Access CDBG Funding:

- **Identify Community Needs:** Assess the immediate imminent threats in your area.
- **Develop a Project Plan:** Outline the scope, goals, and expected outcomes.
- **Secure Partnerships:** Collaborate with local organizations and stakeholders.
- **Consult with HCR:** Submit an application.
