Residential Emergency Services to Offer (Home) Repairs to the Elderly

The Program assists homeowners aged 60 and over with the cost of emergency home repairs that eliminate hazardous conditions or code violations.

RESTORE

How do I get RESTORE grant funds?

RESTORE funds are available to municipalities & not-for-profits to provide grants to eligible homeowners. Homeowners should contact local housing providers and review the list of active RESTORE administrators here: <https://hcr.ny.gov/grant-partners>

Who Qualifies?

- ✓ Eligible homeowners who are 60-years of age or older.
- ✓ Total household income cannot be greater than 100% of the area median income.
- ✓ Assisted residential unit must be the primary, permanent residence of the eligible senior citizen homeowner.

Examples of Emergency Repairs

Alterations include, but are not limited to:

- Correction of serious structural issues
- Stabilization, repair or replacement of damaged or leaking roof, vents and gutters
- Broken, inoperable or unsecured window or exterior door repair or replacement
- Repairs to deteriorated interior or exterior stairs and means of egress
- Accessibility modifications
- Repairs to or replacement of failed HVAC systems and chimneys
- Mold remediation
- Electrical repairs or utility system upgrades to address healthy and safety conditions
