## Enhance Your Local Emergency Services with CDBG Funding



The State **Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)** program can provide up to \$1 million in critical funding to help communities improve emergency response services. Whether you're upgrading fire stations, enhancing emergency medical services, or investing in disaster preparedness, CDBG funding can help ensure your community is safe, resilient, and well-equipped to handle emergencies.

Effective emergency services save lives. Communities must be prepared to respond quickly to fires, medical emergencies, natural disasters, and other crises. CDBG funds can be applied to a wide range of projects including:

- Improve response times for fire and EMS services
- Upgrade fire stations, equipment, and vehicles
- Enhance emergency communication and dispatch systems
- Increase public safety infrastructure and resources

### Safety & Preparedness How to Access CDBG Funding:

- **Identify Community Needs** – Assess the specific needs of emergency service providers in your area.
- **Develop a Project Plan** – Outline the scope, goals, and expected outcomes.
- **Secure Partnerships** – Collaborate with local organizations and stakeholders.
- **Consult with HCR** – Submit an Application.
